


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Meet The Family

Searles Leisure Resort is a family resort that offers holidays on the Norfolk coast of 'Sunny Hunny'. 70 years as a limited company and 90 years since the start of the holiday resort we know today.

In 1929 Geoffrey Searle began his career in tourism when his love for the coastline led him to start pleasure boat trips on the Wash and donkey rides on the beach at Hunstanton.

On the field where he kept his donkeys, Geoffrey would let caravan pitches in exchange for a bag of potatoes. By the summer of 1934 this was the start of the Searles Leisure Resort we know today.

Geoffrey married Margaret and had two sons and three daughters to continue the family business. In 1966 eldest son, Richard Searle became General Manager and married his wife, Linda. By 1969 he was made a Director of the caravan park under the watchful eye of his father Geoffrey.

Richard most certainly learned well, as in 2001 he was honoured by Her Majesty the Queen with an MBE for services to the Holiday Parks Industry.

Geoffrey's youngest son William was to follow in his father's passion for the sea. William continues to successfully run Searles Sea Tours along the Hunstanton coastline with Seal Safari's and coastal tours in his distinctive Amphibious Vessels 'The Wash Monsters' and is fondly known as Captain Willie!

In 2015 and 2016 Searles Sea Tours was voted No.1 Attraction for 'Things to do in Hunstanton' by Trip Advisor and given the Award of Excellence.

As for the legacy of the donkeys...it was to be Geoffrey's daughter Rosemary who took up the reins. She still today can be seen with her ponies along the beach of Hunstanton central promenade, offering rides to excited children.

In 2006, Richard's eldest son Paul became Managing Director. Paul today, along with younger brother Andrew and sister Joanna, continue to manage the holiday resort that Geoffrey and Richard worked so hard to build.

In 2020 Searles Leisure Resort were awarded Best Holiday Park in Norfolk & Suffolk by the EDP Hoseasons, Suffolk & Norfolk Tourism Awards, this was the fourth time the resort has won this prestigious award.

Over 85 years and four generations, the Searle family continue to build on their legacy to provide 5 star holidays and memorable experiences for all ages for future generations to come.



Searles has long standing partnerships with many of the industrys' leading lodge companies. This means more choice, quicker delivery times and more flexibility with your budget than many other parks.

Each manufacturer has a large range of pre-designed lodges for you to choose from, but that doesn't mean inflexibility. Customising a lodge, or even building your dream from scratch is quick and easy. Our experienced sales team will act as trusted guides making sure you get the best lodge for your personal needs.

All of our modern holiday lodges are now built to residential standards (BS3632) which means you can enjoy a similar standard of heating and insulation in your lodge as you would in a new home.

This allows you to enjoy all the seasonal benefits that the North Norfolk coast has to offer.

Modern materials

Constant innovations in chassis design and steel fabrication mean that new lodges now have a much longer lifespan. PVC(u) double glazing maximises energy efficiency, while wall and roof structures are made of a combination of modern materials all engineered to maximise usability and minimise maintenance.



Steps to Buying

1 Arrange an appointment to view the new and pre-owned holiday lodges available.



On your visit one of our friendly sales team will tour you around the Resort and the lodges available, they will discuss all ongoing costs and benefits of being an owner.

During our tour feel free to talk to other owners we may meet, who are more than happy to give their feedback.

2 Choose your ideal lodge, if you're buying a show home we will take a £5,000 deposit and go through the contract with you, the contract is approved by the British Holiday and Home Parks Association so protects both you and us. There is no need to involve solicitors unless you want to. We often build bespoke lodges for owners or offer upgrades like hot tubs or extended decking, if this is the case there may be different deposits and timescales involved.













Now its time to go shopping for all the new home and kitchenware to make it yours, don't forget the bucket and spade or a new set of clubs.



If you have purchased a pre-owned or show home lodge we would normally have it ready for you within 2 to 3 weeks. Once you have paid the balance we will arrange a time for handover, when one the friendly sales team will walk you through the lodge. They will explain the basics and answer any questions you may have about the lodge before leaving you to enjoy your future holidays.



Frequently Asked Questions

Can I live in my holiday home?

No. You can stay in it whilst on holiday but you must live somewhere else and we will require you to provide proof of the address of your main residence and cannot be the address of someone else such as a relative.

Can I receive post at the caravan / lodge?

No. Your holiday home cannot be used as a postal address, if there is something you need delivered to your holiday home please discuss this with the owners reception and we may be able to take this in for you if we are aware its coming.

How long can I stay in my holiday home?

The season varies with the different areas but for the caravans it is around 10.5 months and lodges 11 months.

During this time you can use it when you like on a holiday basis but the essence of holiday use is that you must have a home elsewhere to be on holiday from.

How long can my holiday home stay on site?

All new lodges on Redgate Court will be sold with a "Tenure" of 45 years. If you were to purchase a pre-owned lodge you would get the remainder of this term from the model year of the lodge.

This means you can keep the lodge on the resort for 45 years, as long as it is kept in a good state of repair as per the licence agreement. If you were to purchase a pre-owned lodge that is being sold on behalf of the owner, you would get the remainder of the term on their original agreement. The tenure will be made clear to you before the purchase and will be shown on your contract.

Can I sublet my holiday home?

No. Many of our owners choose Searles for the peace, quiet and continuity afforded by owning their own lodge or caravan.

Allowing owners to let their holiday homes would change the dynamic considerably with different families arriving and departing regularly and be detrimental to the relaxed atmosphere our owners enjoy.

Can I use the facilities on site?

Yes, as an owner you get photo ID cards to gain access to our facilities and discount on your food and drink. A full list of benefits is detailed on page 15. The main facilities and entertainment are normally accessible from March through to the end of October, outside the main season there will be limited facilities available. However during this time Searles













host a variety of themed entertainment breaks, these are chargeable but are often discounted to owners although some may be private parties.

All opening times and special event details can be sourced from the main reception.

Do you allow dogs on site?

Yes, as long as they are well behaved and kept on leads. Certain breeds are not allowed as detailed in our park rules.

Can we build our own decking?

No. All decking, patios and storage boxes must be purchased through the resort to keep our 5 star standards. You are allowed to maintain these yourself but if you require an outside contractor to work on your holiday home rather than our maintenance team this must be approved in writing before going ahead.

Can I have a BBQ by my holiday home?

Yes, as long as it conforms to approved safety standards.

Can i have a washing line by my holiday home?

Yes we allow rotary washing lines but they must be removed when not in use and the spike installed by Searles.
